OF JANUARY***

No important move of God, can be accomplished without Prayer, Intercession and Prayer Warriors.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As this new year 2010 begins, let us "*Kick Off*" and start this New Year with Prayer, as you gather and meet together, at various venues for perhaps a fellowship meal, to acknowledge God's sovereignty and dependence on Him.

Let us Confess afresh, our need of God, for "We cannot do it with out Him" ~ We are helpless without His grace. It is :-

Not our ability but God's in us

Let us pray and commit again afresh, our very lives and work to God through ACC.

At times we can look ahead to the future, with perhaps a sense of uncertainty but in prayer God can stir our hearts as we come to Him in prayer, renew our sense of purpose, empower us, and give us renewed heart for the work of the Kingdom.

In Acts 1 : 14b it says, "They all joined together constantly in prayer"

Acts records for us, "*a prayer vigil*" with the fervent and persistent prayer, that was a real feature of Acts.

PRAYER KICK OFF 2010

I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

(1 Timothy 2:1-2)

Pray daily for our Leaders that God will encourage, refresh and renew our Leadership of ACC as they work strongly for the advancement of the Kingdom.

In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' (Acts 20:35)

Pray for the strengthening spiritually and physically and resolve of those who work and sacrifice for the Kingdom, in order that together we can work together to build God's Kingdom, seeing individual lives changed and transformed. Pray that we will give and act with generosity, in all aspects of our lives. As this will bring healing and grace into the darkest corners of our Church and communities where people suffer, are lonely and need to hear and receive the Good News of Salvation.

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. (Romans 8 : 11)

We wait upon you God, and we ask that you would act mightily in Your Church.

I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the LORD, give yourselves no rest and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth. (Isaiah 62 : 6 & 7)

Pray for a conviction in hearts as to the truth of the gospel, taking the blinkers off eyes and giving clear vision as to the truth.

Pray that God will raise up and send out teams to reach individuals

Pray for the Prayer Network, for its six points in our terms of reference, that we can fulfil them.

That the Prayer Network can provide prayer support for individuals, congregations, networks, commissions, the National Council and the mission of the Church as a whole.

Pray for our Networking with other confessing movements.

- Prayer exalts God and Prayer helps the vision mature in us
- God works on us to prepare us for the vision, and empowers by His Holy Spirit to fulfill this vision, because this call is beyond us to fulfill in our own strength. Prayer request help.
- As we Pray God prepares the way and God tells us what to do, when to do it, and how to do it;
- As we “look up’ to God in Prayer, God keeps us encouraged, fresh and energized to the call of God for our lives through ACC.
- Prayer keeps our spirits sensitive to the subtle changes of God’s direction for us as individuals and corporately.
- Prayer keeps us aware of God’s opportunities, and to hear Him speaking to our hearts to encourage others with loving, uplifting, up building, and affirming words.
- In Prayer we see our own sinfulness and our need to confess where we have failed to walk aligned to God’s will.

Father it is with great joy in our hearts that you are using us as instruments. Consecrate all our thoughts, words and deeds, that everything we do, say and think be empowered by Your Holy Spirit, and glorify You in everything we do. We ask for unity, love, patience and understanding! We dont know that journey that lies ahead but we have the faith that You are with us through it all. All of these we ask through the Mighty Name of Your Son Jesus Christ
